We are responsive and reassuring during this process, keeping you comfortable and updated with our work towards your goals.






Quality Education




US. Ambassador Michael J. Murphy and AmCham BiH


Vanja Đenadija

Amila:






Community Engagement

During the first day of the event, our Client Delivery Manager, Azra Kahrović, participated in the panel: "The Future of Education and Jobs of the Future."



Our Senior Software Engineer, Bojana Dejanović, was on the expert jury. They selected two winners, one team among high school students and the other among university students.


Collaboration with the Diplomatic Winter Bazaar

The EEMs are psychologists with training in psychotherapy. They prioritize regular one-on-one communication to promptly identify and resolve potential problems faced by colleagues. Their role is to guarantee a distinct, enjoyable, and motivating experience for all company employees. They aid leaders in managing teams, fostering an atmosphere of mutual respect and trust, and promoting transparent communication.

Workshops

Throughout 2023, our Employee Experience Managers facilitated educational workshops for employees covering a range of topics:

- Imposter Syndrome
- Sleep Science: Understanding the importance of sleep and techniques for improving sleep quality
- Overcoming Procrastination
- Effective Time Management

These workshops were open to all employees and were suggested by the workforce themselves. Additionally, Employee Experience Managers conducted team-specific workshops to address specific challenges. These sessions focused on areas such as communication, conflict resolution, mediation, and overall team and individual development, fostering a healthier and more supportive work environment.

Additional health insurance

Klika prioritizes the well-being and satisfaction of its employees by providing additional health insurance coverage. We understand the importance of ensuring our employees have access to comprehensive healthcare services.

Energy Usage Reduction

In 2023, KLIKA has continued to pursue initiatives to reduce our carbon footprint and minimize our environmental impact. We have implemented energy-efficient practices and prioritized waste reduction across our operations. Furthermore, our ambitious targets to decrease greenhouse gas emissions demonstrate our unwavering commitment to environmental stewardship.

One notable achievement from the past year was the successful reduction of our carbon footprint through the adoption of energy-efficient practices companywide. By offering remote work options to all employees, we were able to decrease energy consumption in our offices by 15%. We have acquired the equipment and technologies necessary for remote work, ensuring that employees can perform their tasks efficiently and effectively from home. Our Remote work initiative not only enhances the overall quality of life for our workforce but also contributes to reductions in commute emissions, energy consumption, and the embodied carbon associated with workplace construction. We have also made efforts to reduce our corporate travel activities, implementing virtual meeting platforms and encouraging employees to use alternative transportation like public transit when possible. We decreased our corporate travel activities by 80% compared to the previous year. These sustainable initiatives reflect our ongoing commitment to corporate social responsibility and environmental conservation.

Waste

Management

Klika aims to promote sustainable and responsible business practices across all its value chains. Our business is based on the principle that our requirements and processes are continuously evaluated to avoid working against the planet whenever possible.

We are committed to respecting sustainability principles, educating people on reducing packaging materials, waste, and promoting reusable packaging. Preference is given to suppliers with smaller, environmentally friendly packaging and work systems in line with waste reduction policies.

Looking ahead, we plan to further prioritize suppliers and collaborators who hold certificates for environmental management systems, aligning with our long-term sustainability goals.

Food waste is a global challenge that we take seriously. At our events, we carefully pack leftover food in eco-friendly containers for employees and guests to take home, reducing food waste and promoting environmental responsibility.








Encouraging product and packaging reuse is another focus area for us. We package gifts for employees in soda boxes and paper, supporting ecologically responsible operations of local businesses owned and run by women.

By prioritizing sustainability, we aim to inspire others in the industry to adopt eco-friendly strategies, contributing to a more sustainable future for all.

We have made significant progress in reducing plastic cup usage in our offices, achieving an impressive 80% reduction. This accomplishment was made possible by replacing disposable bottles and cups with reusable paper or glass dishes.

In 2023, we transitioned to using electronic signatures, achieving our goal of conducting business 100% without paper. We also prioritize electronic waste management through our partnership with the NGO Kompjuteri nade which repairs and redistributes used laptops and electronic equipment to socially vulnerable individuals, particularly children in rural areas. Our sustainable initiatives not only benefit the environment but also strengthen our relationships with stakeholders.





Other green initiatives

Klika employees actively participated in the River Bosna Cleaning Initiative, demonstrating their commitment to environmental sustainability and community involvement. Together with 25 members of the Ronilački klub Bosna, and other volunteers they pulled out around 80 bags of waste, which comes to **250-280k** (about 617.29 lb.).

Clients

We are proud of our Client delivery team, which continuously supports 40+ teams through 10+ clients in each phase: setup, expansion, and transformation.

During the past year, our Client Delivery team has dedicated efforts to enhancing the business model. Recognizing the importance of supporting teams to improve efficiency for optimal client delivery, they increased resources and empowered team members with greater autonomy. Using client satisfaction scores and business review meetings as benchmarks, their objective was to improve communication and foster stronger client relationships.

In collaboration with the Business development team, they prepared a Client Delivery Handbook that will help our potential clients understand the way we work.

This handbook focuses on deepening client relationships, ensuring transparency in our approach, fostering collaboration with the Business Development and Engineering teams, and advancing our technical skills to better serve our clients.

Additionally, five of our Scrum Masters are undergoing Google Project Management education to strengthen their capabilities.

We will continue to actively engage with our stakeholders, listen to their feedback, and adapt our practices accordingly to further improve our corporate governance and enhance our social impact.



Local Community

As a company driven by the imperative to give back to the community and promote social responsibility, KLIKA supports and participates in initiatives that benefit the community and society.

In September 2023, our CEO Edin Deljkić had the opportunity to share Klika's ESG best practices and innovations at "The Future of Sustainable Business in Bosnia and Herzegovina and the Western Balkans region — ESG standards and gender equality" conference.

As a company with 45% female employees, 40% of them in leadership positions across the organization, and with a commitment to SDGs and ESG, we try to set a positive example for others in our business environment which still hasn't reached the optimum state.





Our colleague Fatima Kamali conducted a 2-day UX/UI workshop at the "Smart (IT) girls - smarter automation" boot camp, which was organized as part of the #ITgirls initiative. During the workshop, the girls had the opportunity to learn the principles of UX as they crafted user personas and identified their needs and challenges until they reached an ideal solution. From user stories to user flow diagrams, they sketched low-fi wireframes using pens and paper and then transformed them into mid-fidelity prototypes in Figma.

Our co-founder, Maja Mameledžija, had the honor of being a guest speaker on the panel discussing Women Entrepreneurship and the Digital Era which was organized as a part of the IT.Reboot Conference Vol. 3.

We are thrilled to witness the continuous growth of this conference each year, introducing more individuals to the dynamic IT industry. As it happens, the conference is taking place in Travnik, Maja's hometown, adding a personal touch to her enthusiasm in sharing the vast experience she has gathered over the years in the field of IT.



Bit Alliance and Philanthropic Forum

Klika played a vital role in establishing the Bit Alliance and The Philanthropic Forum, contributing to their strategic planning for many years. To cultivate a positive business environment for further growth of Bosnia and Herzegovina's IT industry, BIT Alliance is consistently working on addressing two key issues faced by IT companies - the scarcity of highly skilled employees and underdeveloped IT industry infrastructure with insufficient development incentives.
